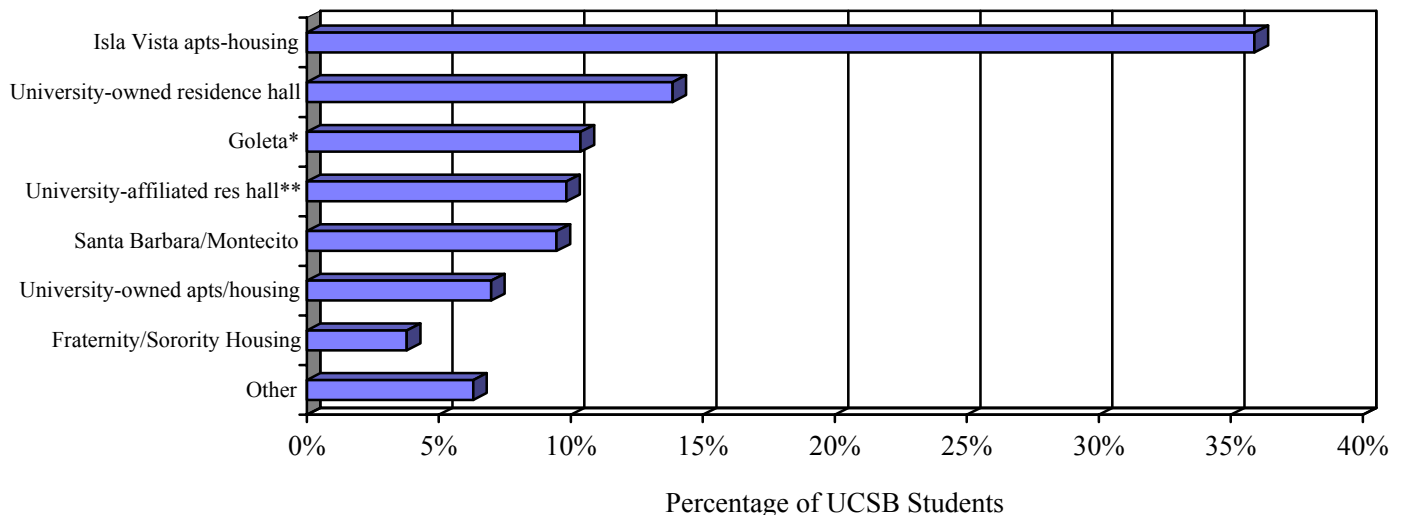

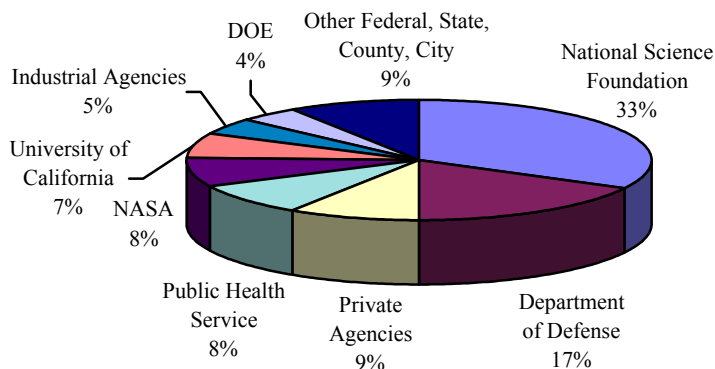
Where UCSB Students Live
