



Total Student Enrollment









School of Origin

Of new undergraduates 74% entered as freshmen, while 26% transferred in at a higher class level. Eighty-seven percent of new freshmen students entered UCSB from public high schools; 12% graduated from private high schools. The majority of transfer students came from community colleges (91%); over a quarter of transfer students came from Santa Barbara City College alone (27%). Other transfer students came from other University of California campuses (3%), the California State University system (2%), and other 4-year colleges (4%).









2005-06 Awards by Sponsor with Breakout of Federal Sponsors






