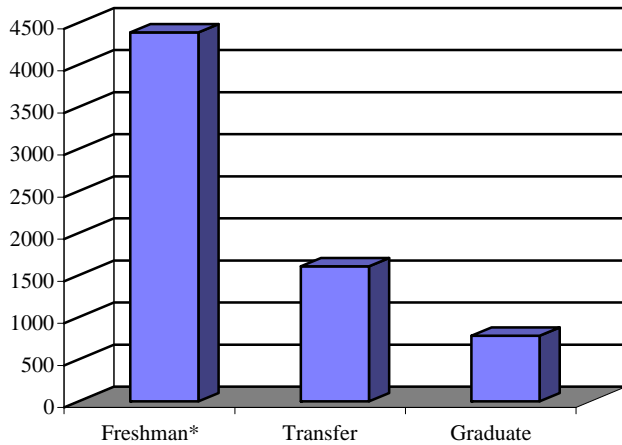

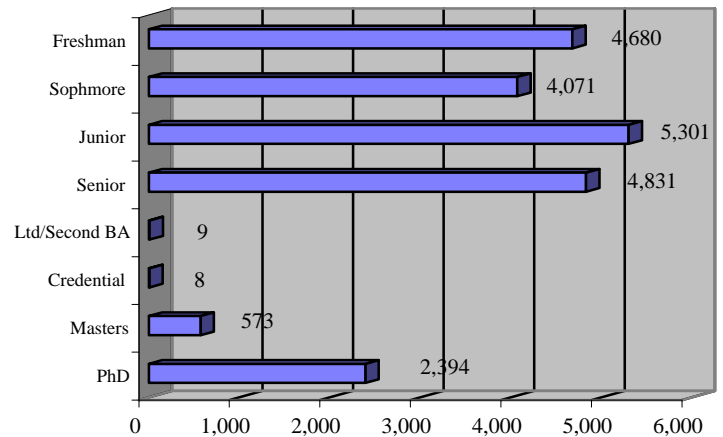

Fall Enrollment by Class Level

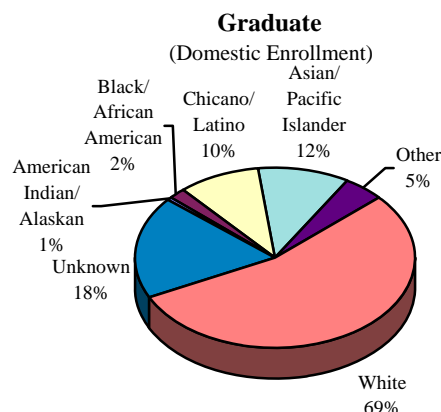
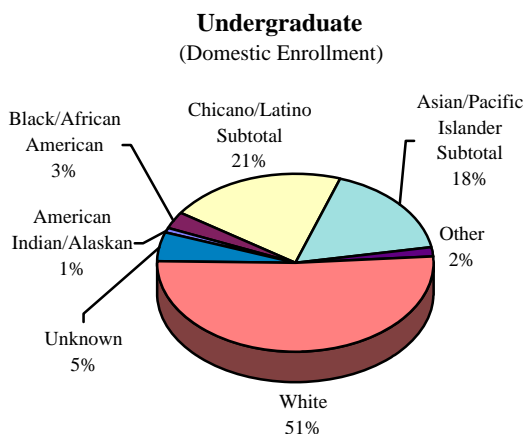

School of Origin

Of new undergraduates 73% entered as freshmen, while 27% transferred in at a higher class level. 87% of new freshmen students entered UCSB from public high schools; 13% graduated from private high schools or were home schooled. The majority of transfer students came from community colleges (91%); over a quarter of transfer students came from Santa Barbara City College alone (27%). Other transfer students came from other University of California campuses (4%), the California State University system (2%), and other 4-year colleges (3%).

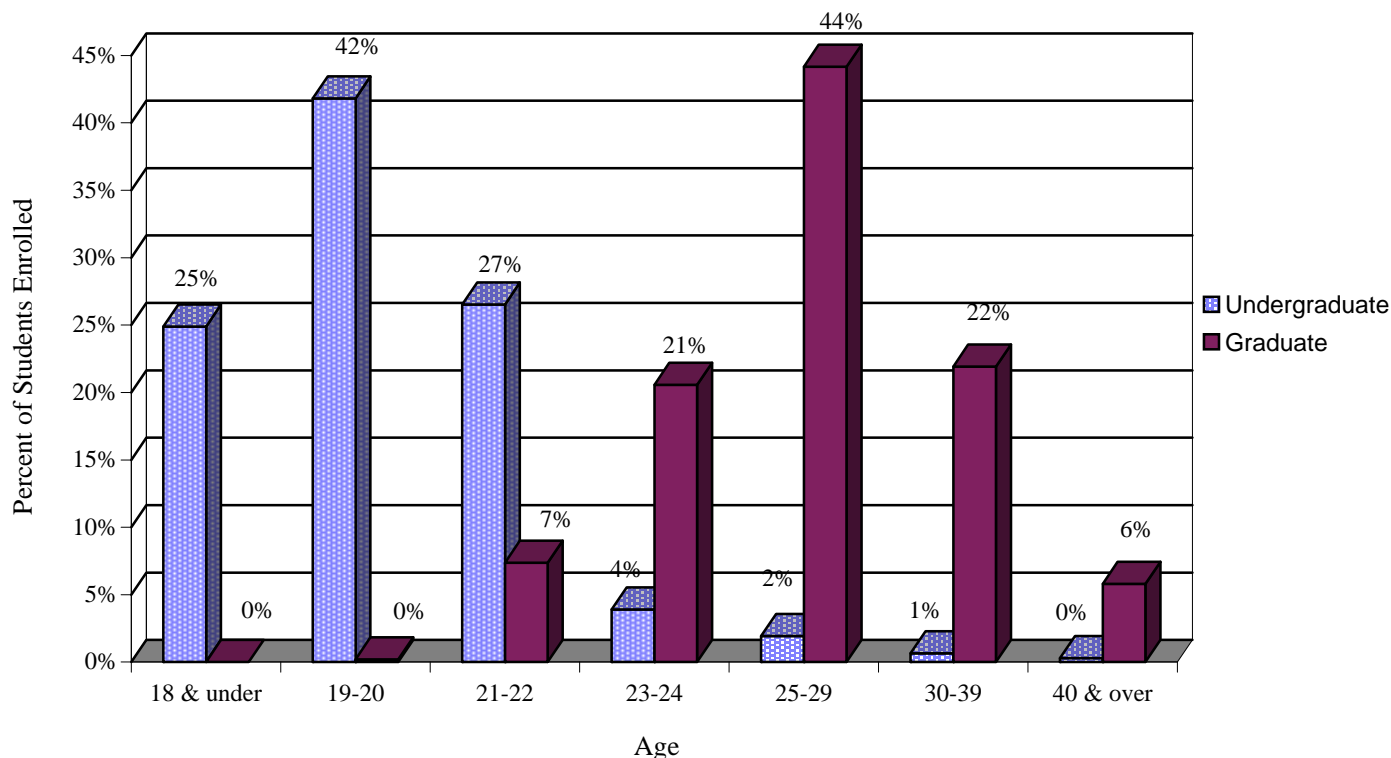

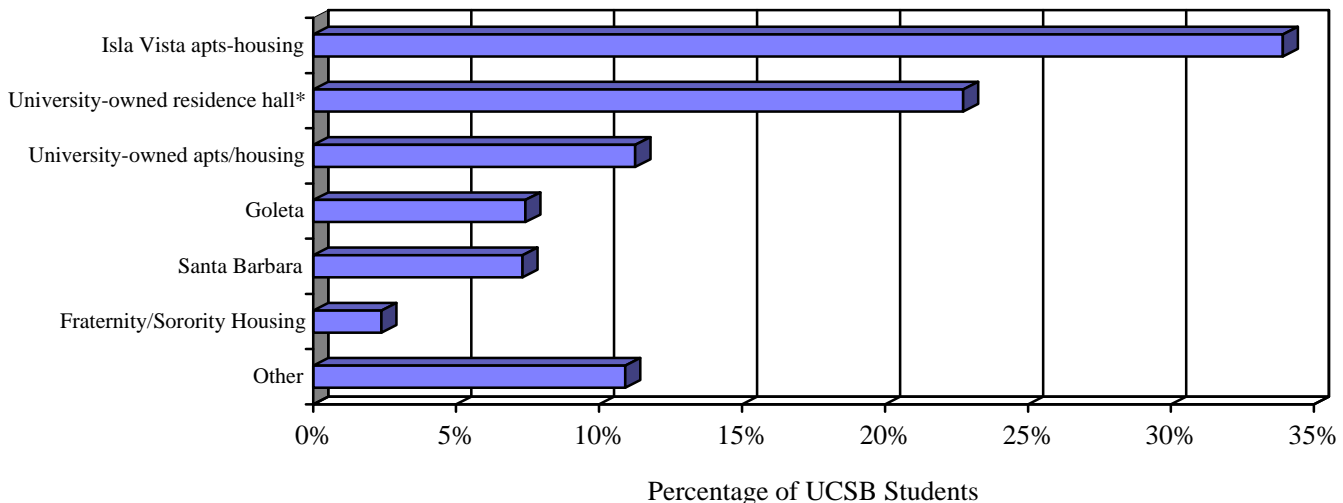

Where UCSB Students Live

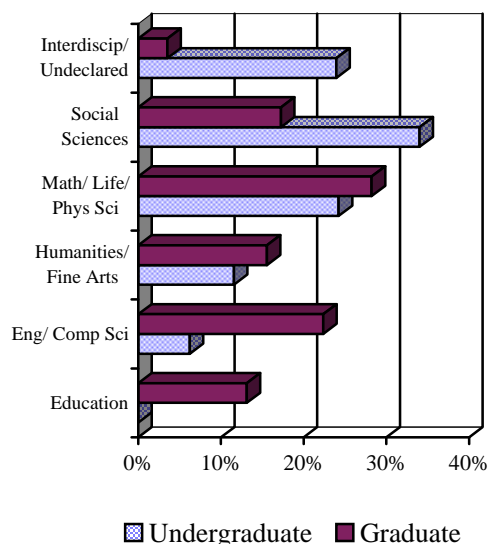

Major Disciplines of UCSB Students



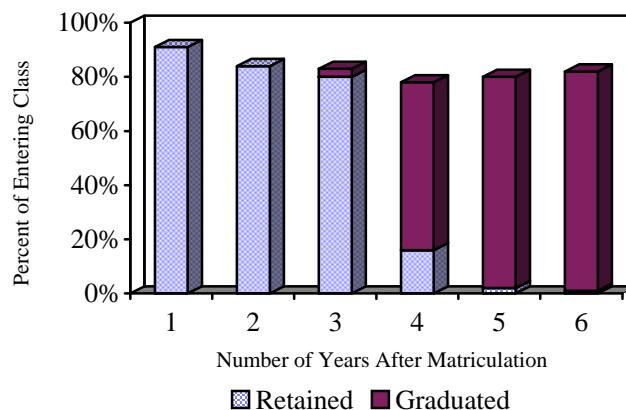

Fall 2002 Freshmen Retention/ Graduation Rate



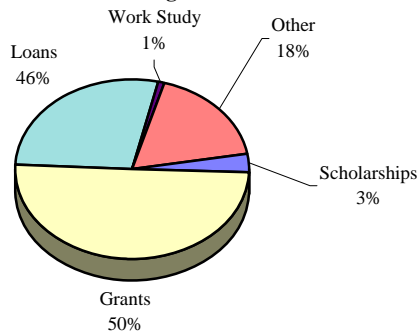

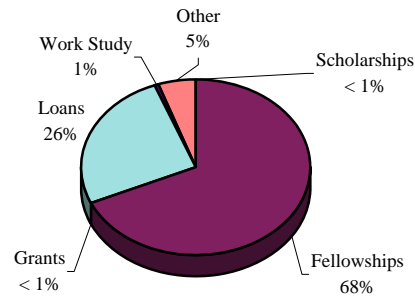

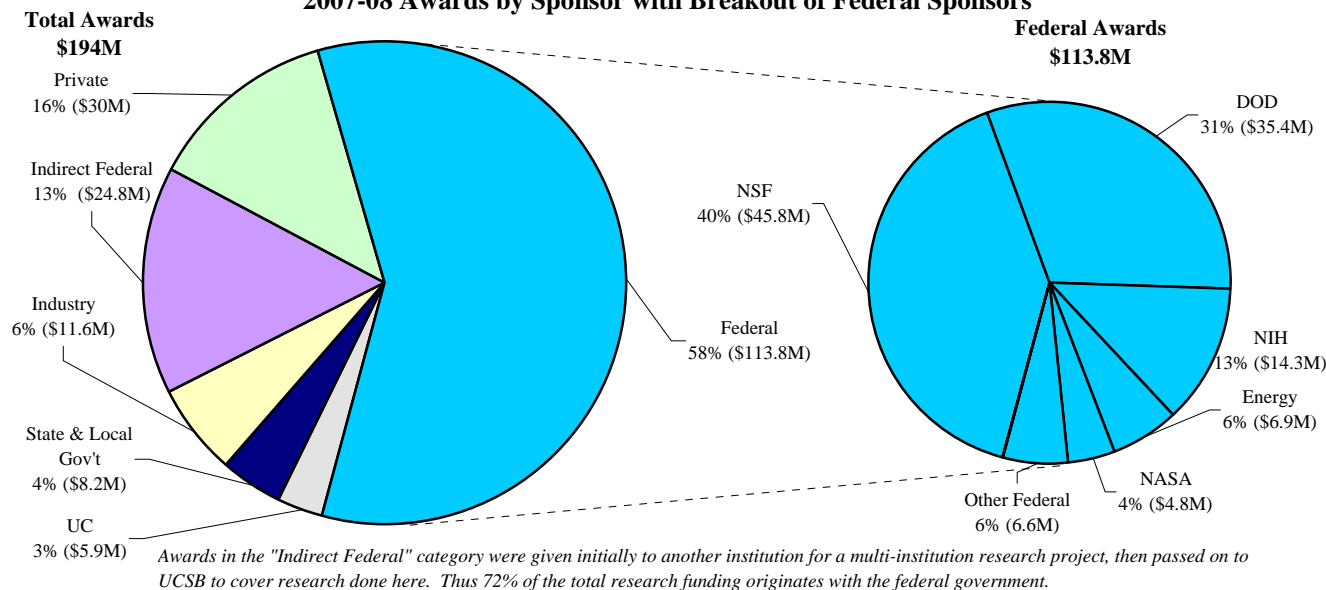

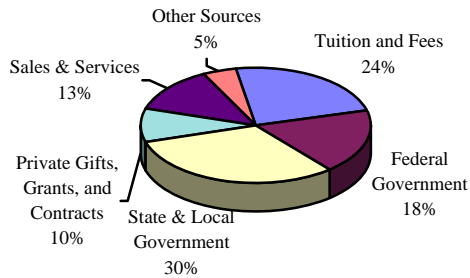

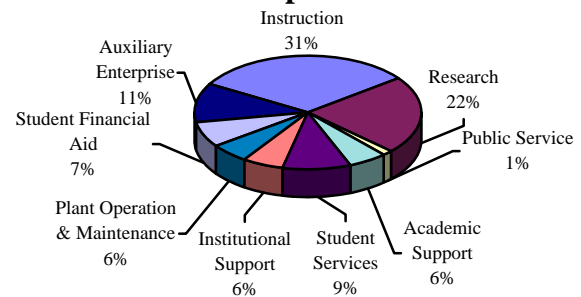
