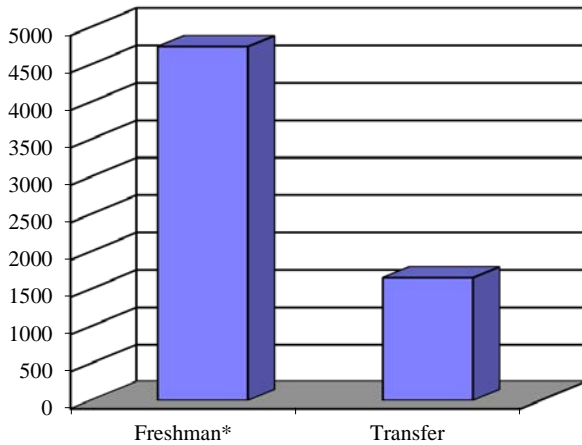

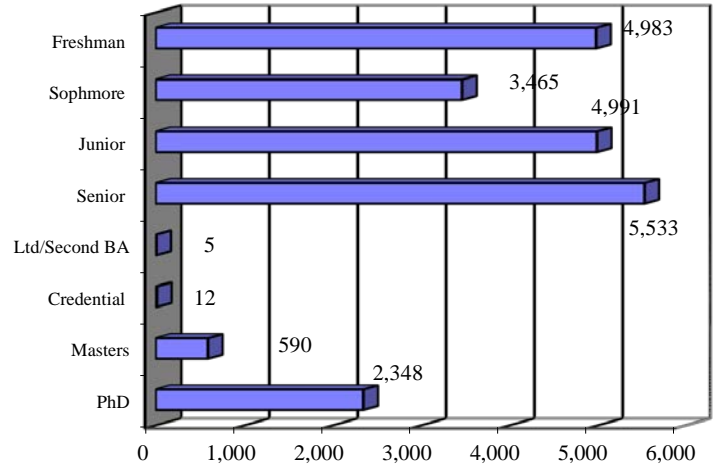

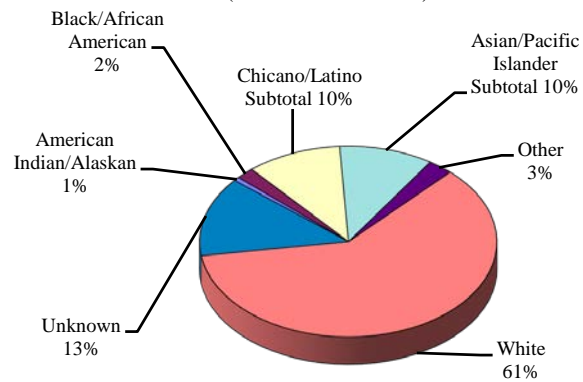

School of Origin

Of new undergraduates 74% entered as freshmen, while 26% transferred in at a higher class level. 86% of new freshmen students entered UCSB from public high schools; 10% graduated from private high schools or were home schooled. The majority of transfer students came from community colleges (94%); over a quarter of transfer students came from Santa Barbara City College alone (23%). Other transfer students came from other University of California campuses (2%), the California State University system (<1%), and other 4-year colleges (2%).

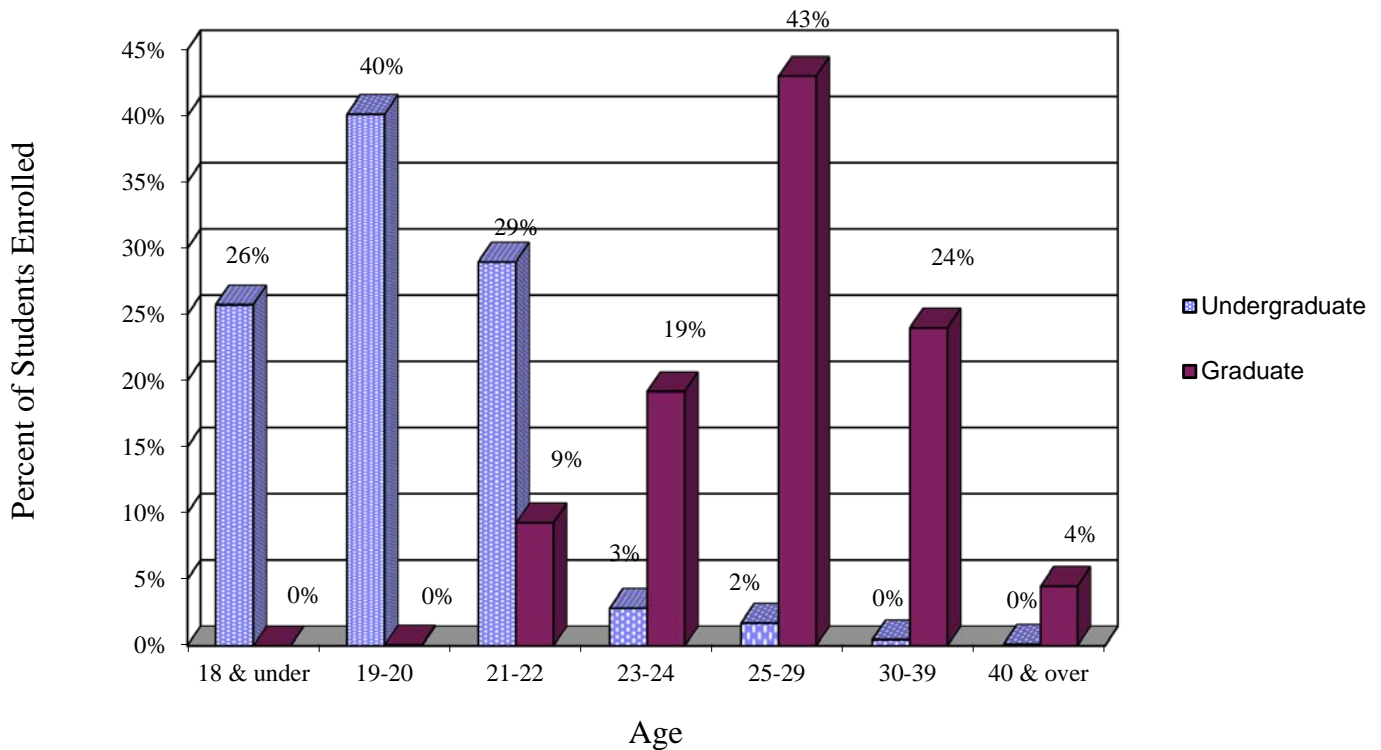

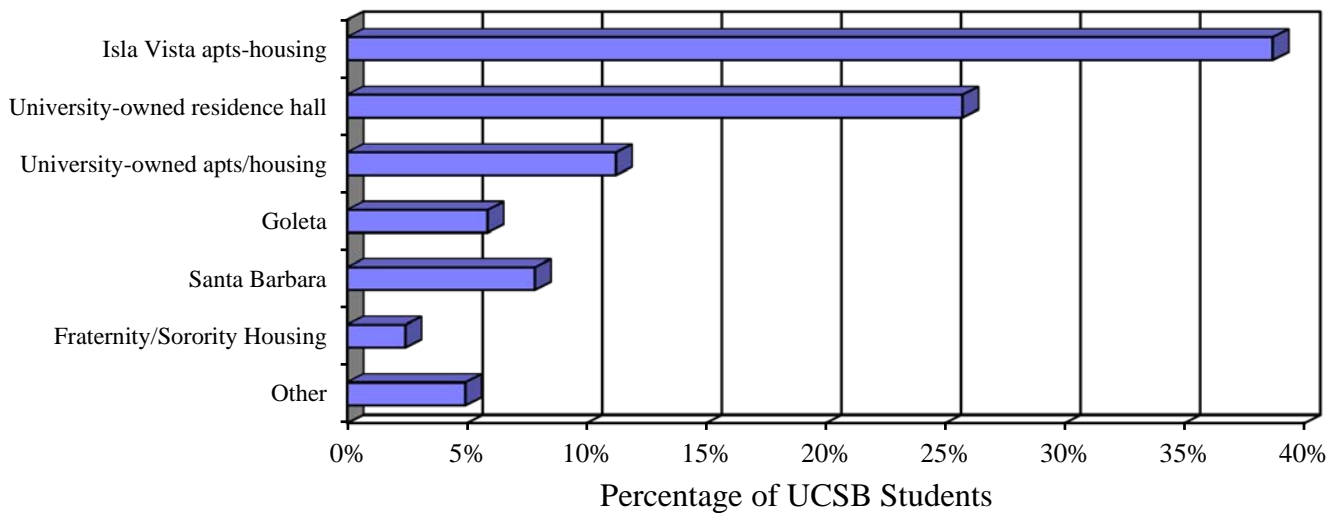

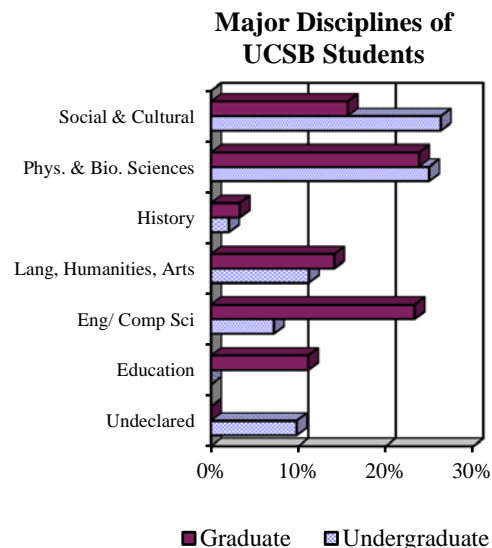

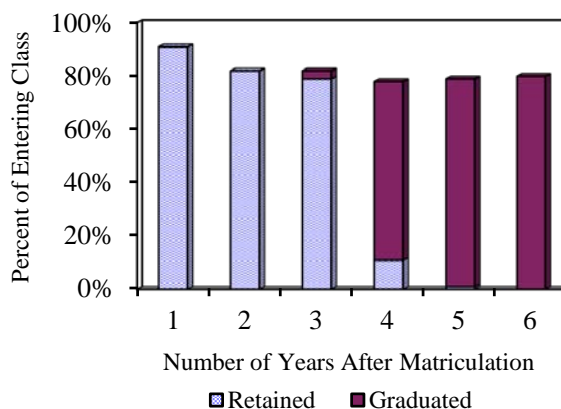

Fall 2006 Freshmen Cohort Retention/ Graduation Rate



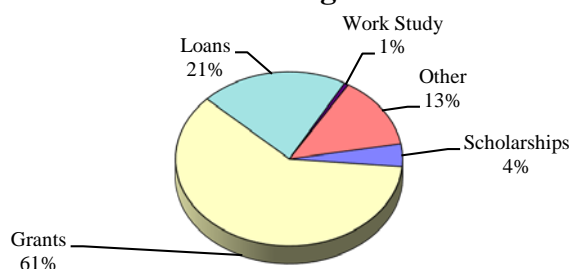

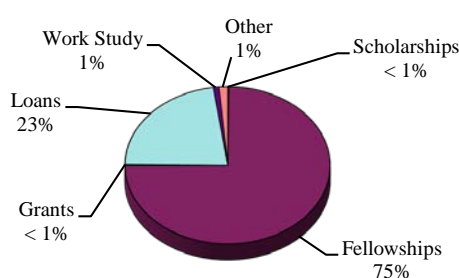

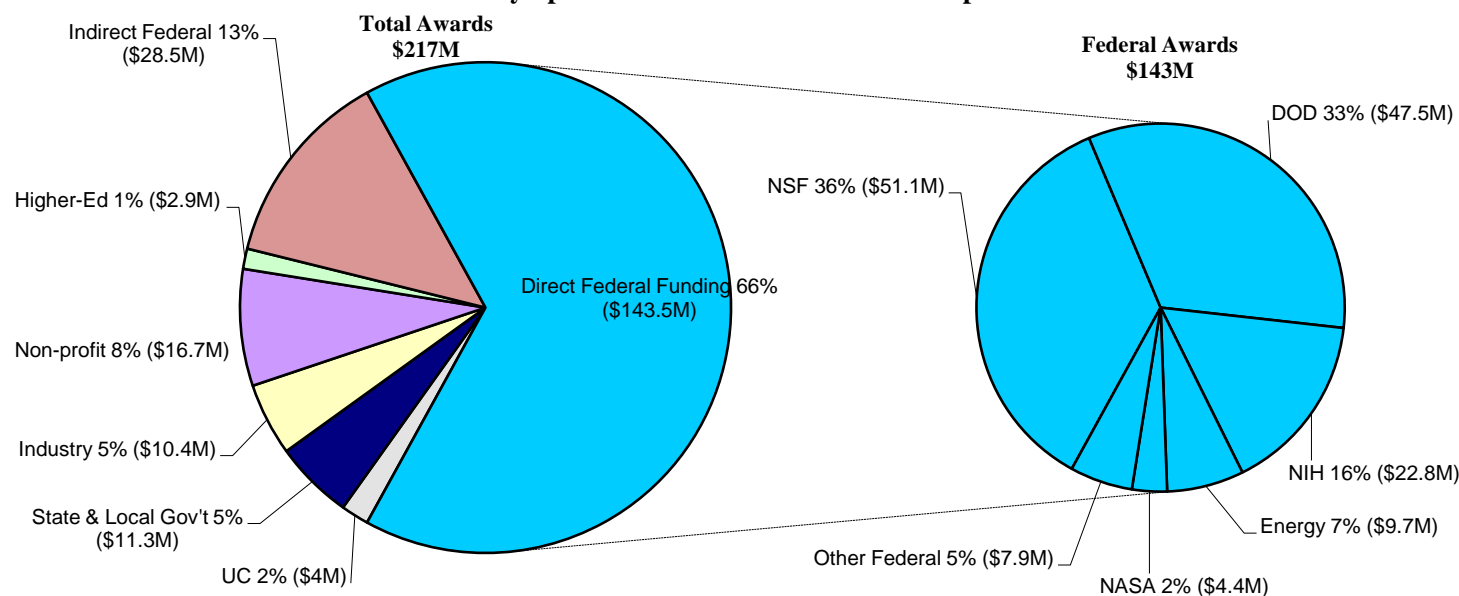

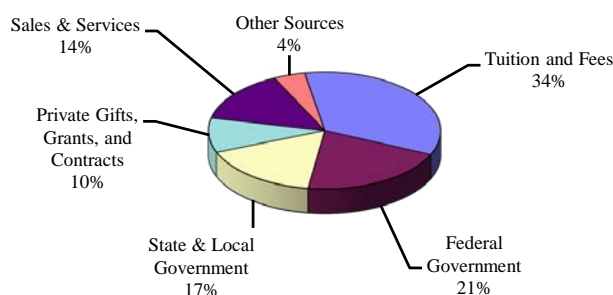

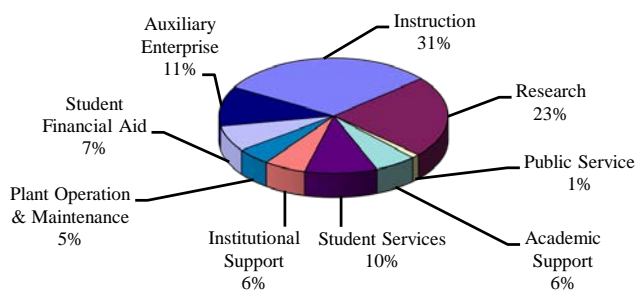
