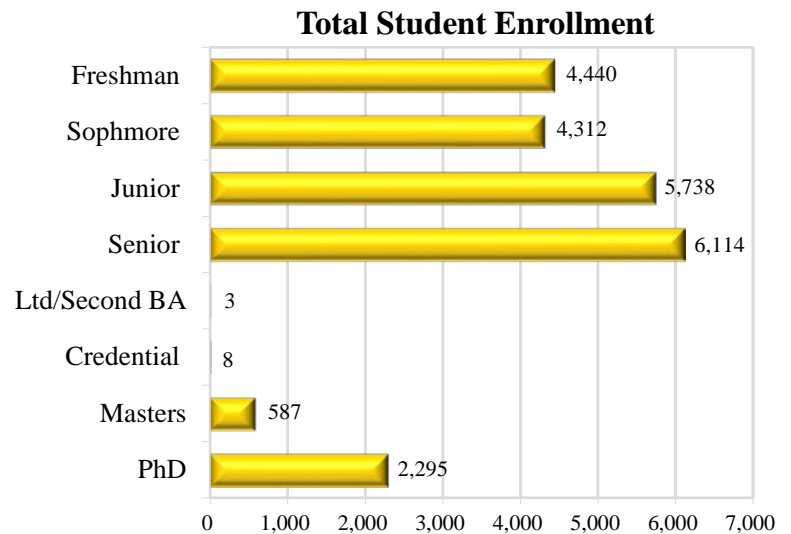
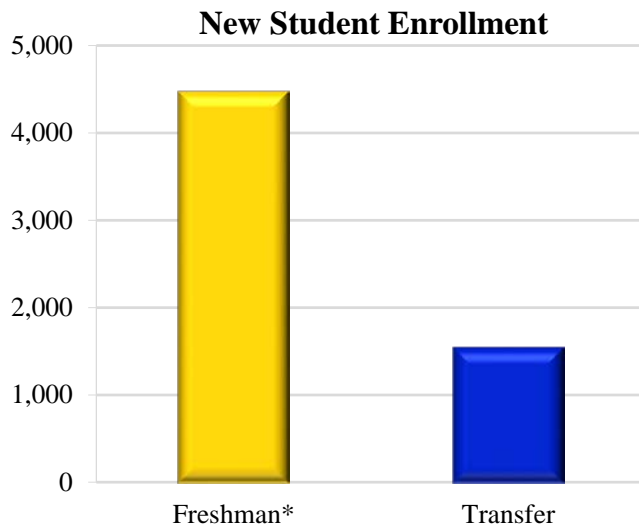

Fall Enrollment by Class Level

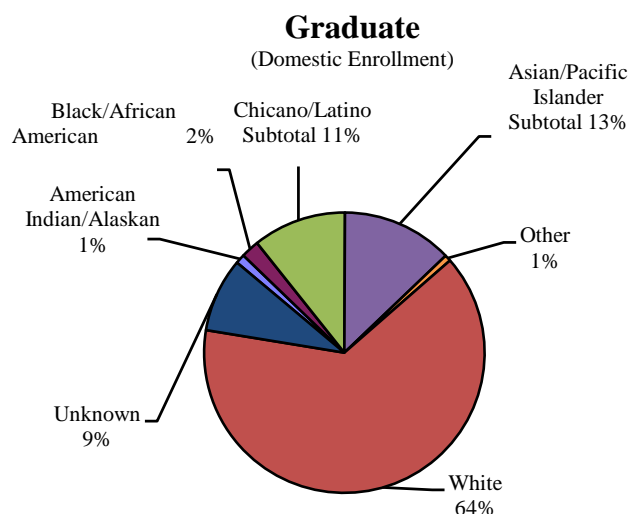
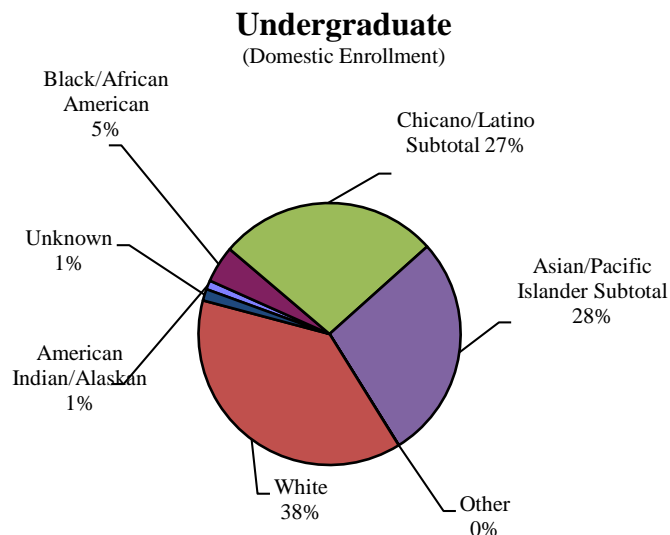

School of Origin

Of new undergraduates 74% entered as freshmen, while 26% transferred in at a higher class level. 84% of new freshmen students entered UCSB from public high schools; 9% graduated from private high schools or were home schooled. The majority of transfer students came from community colleges (94%); about one fifth of transfer students came from Santa Barbara City College alone (21%). Other transfer students came from other University of California campuses (1%), the California State University system (1%), and other 4-year colleges (3%).

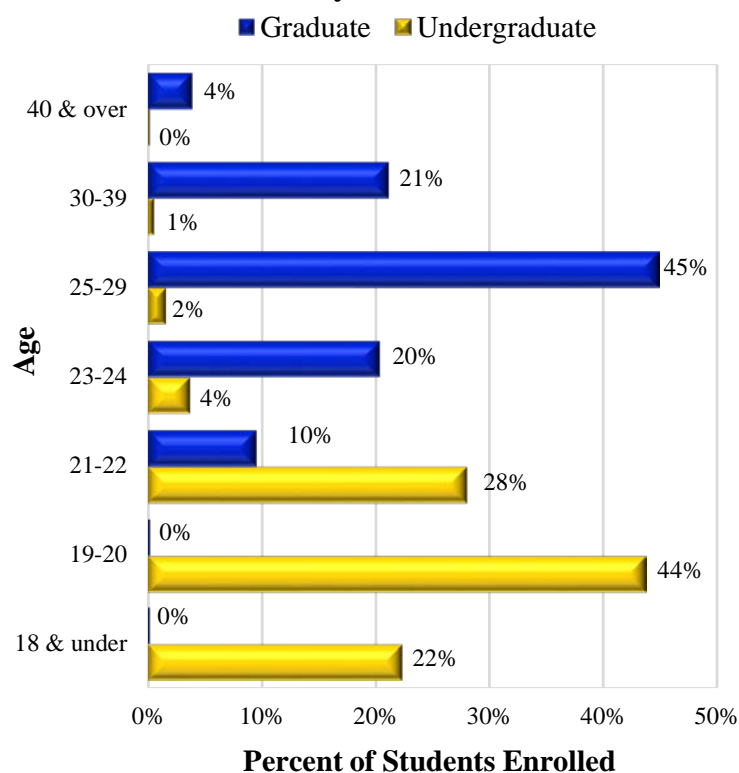

Age Distribution of Students by Class Level



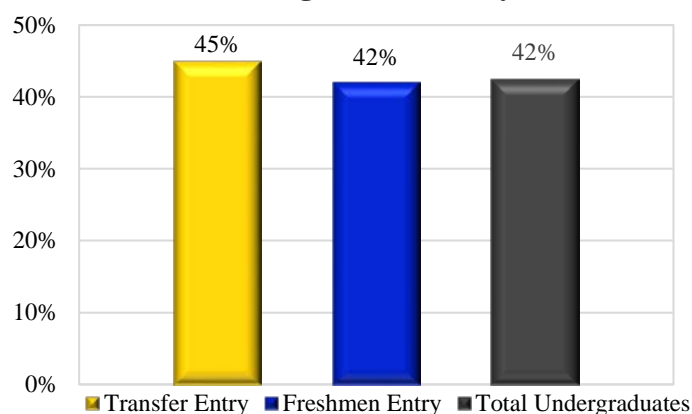

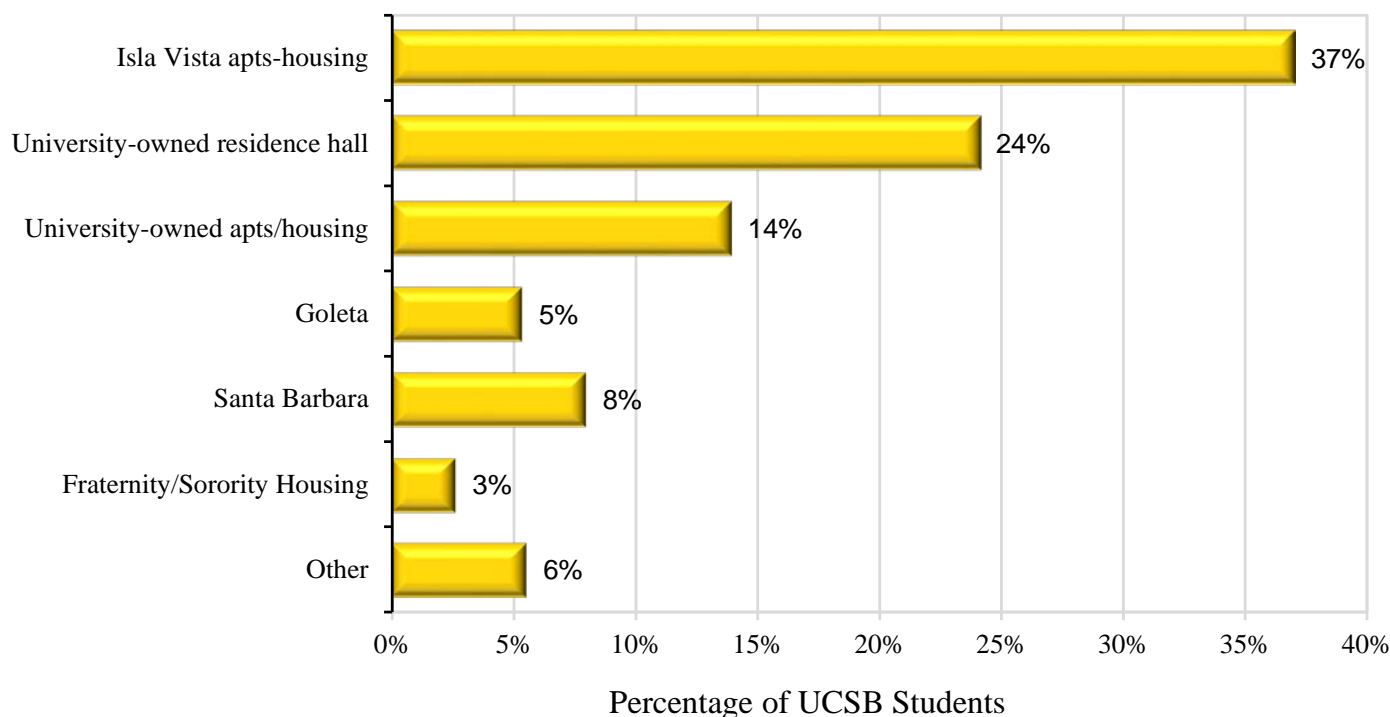

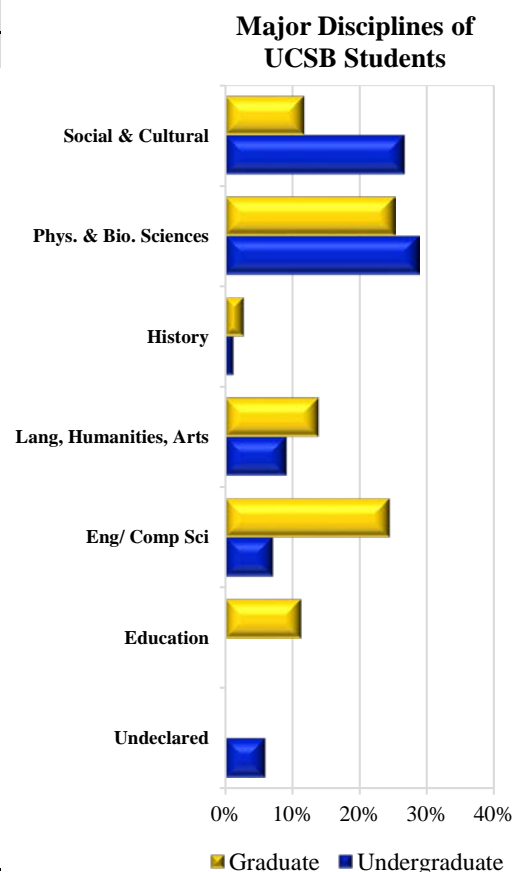

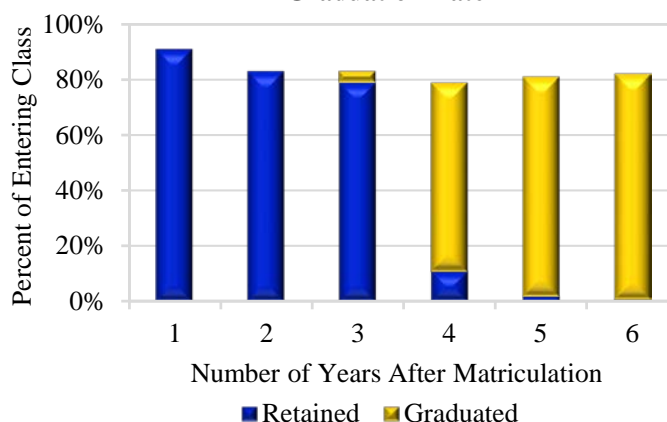

Fall 2009 Freshmen Cohort Retention/ Graduation Rate



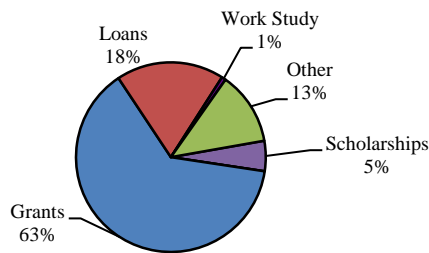

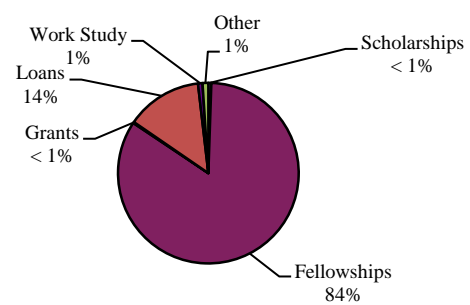

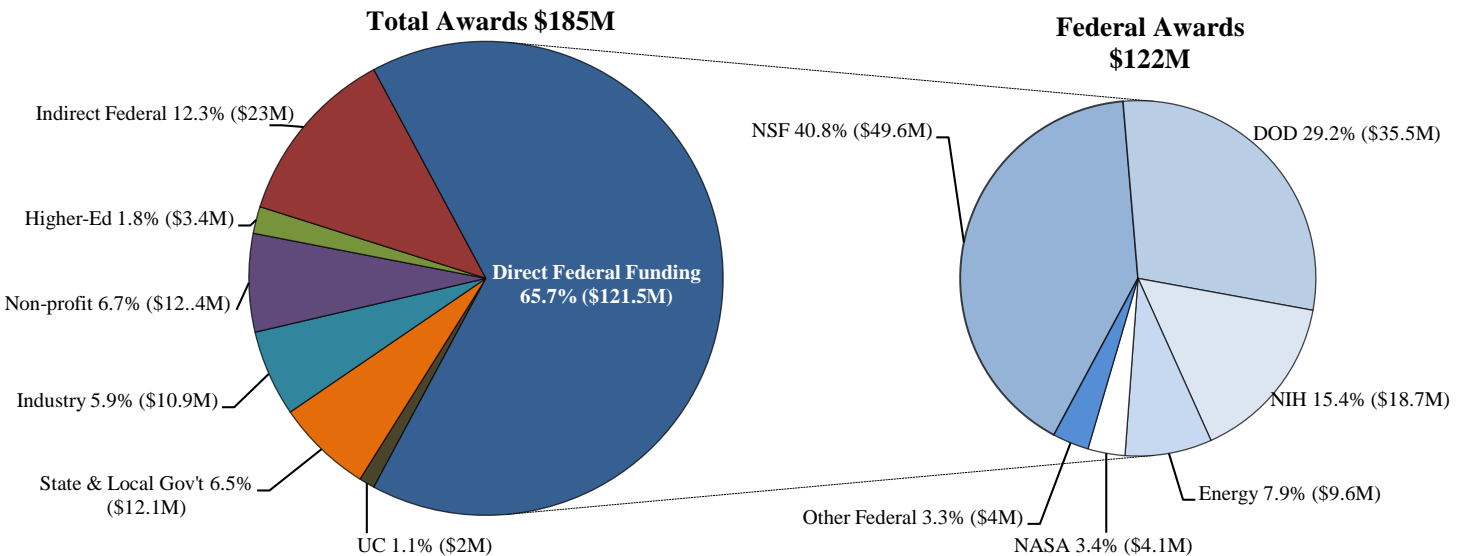

2014-15 Awards by Sponsor with Breakout of Federal Sponsors



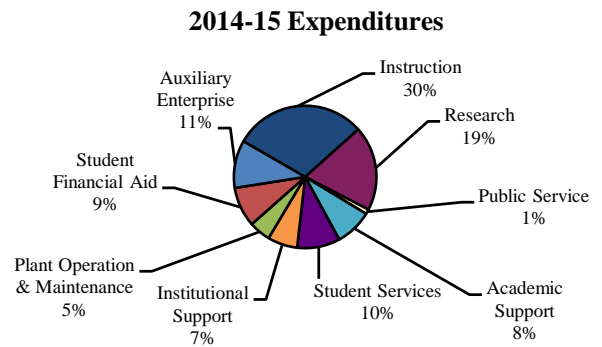
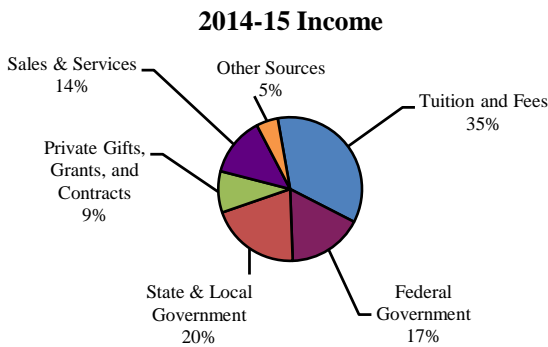
