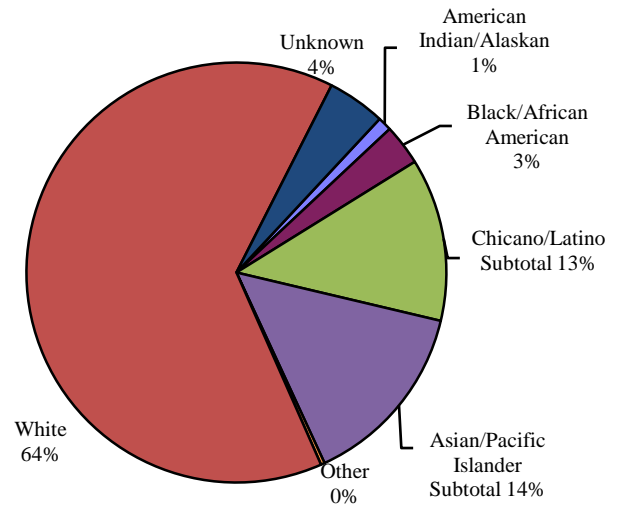
### Undergraduate

## School of Origin

Of new undergraduates 67% entered as freshmen, while 33% transferred in at a higher class level. 79% of new freshmen students entered UCSB from public high schools; 10% graduated from private high schools or were home schooled.

The majority of transfer students came from community colleges (94%); nearly one fifth of transfer students came from Santa Barbara City College alone (18%). Other transfer students came from other University of California campuses (1%), the California State University system (1%), and other 4-year colleges (2%).

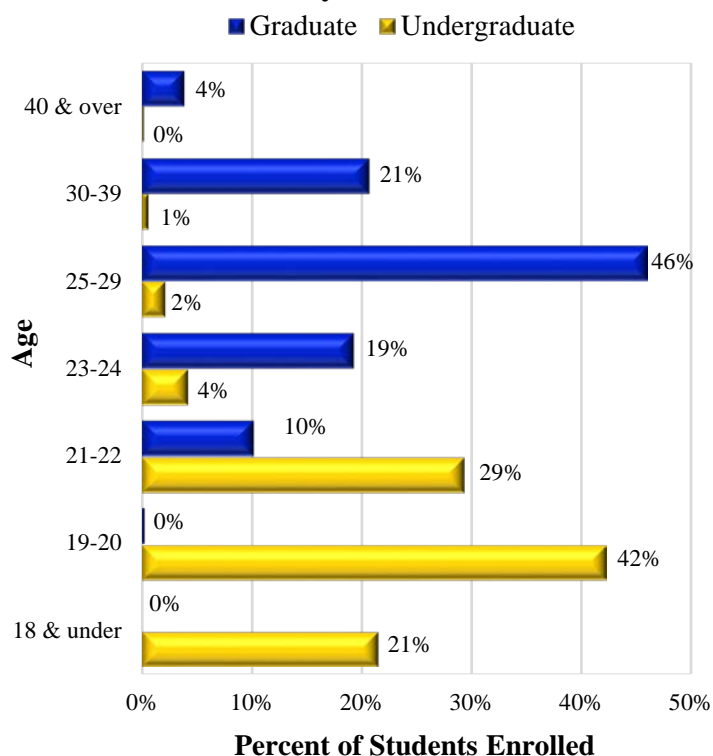

Age Distribution of Students by Class Level



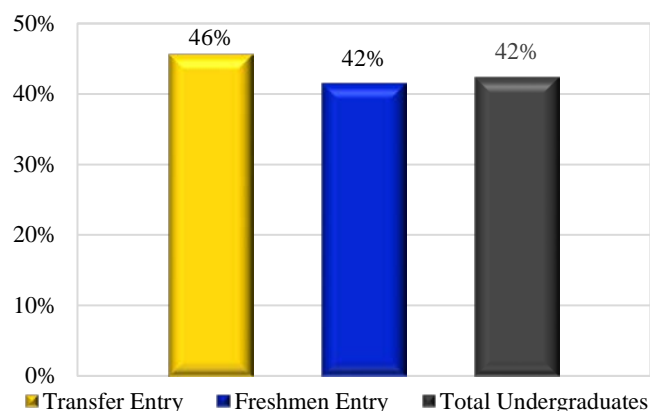

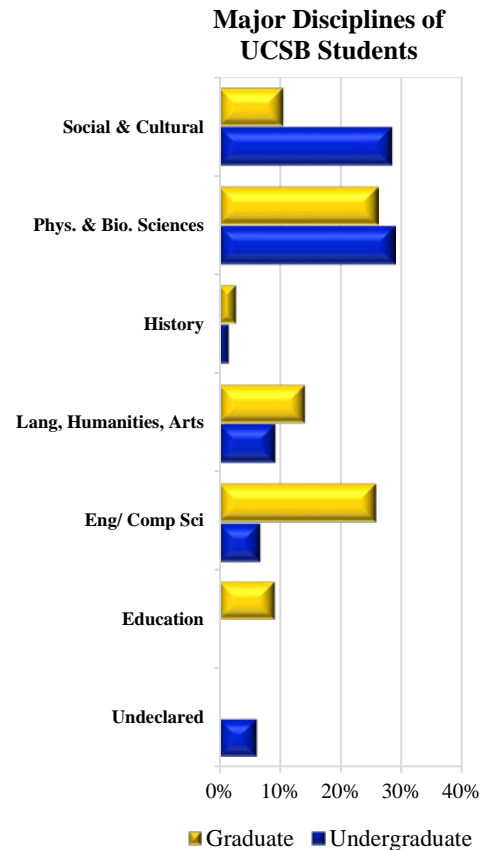

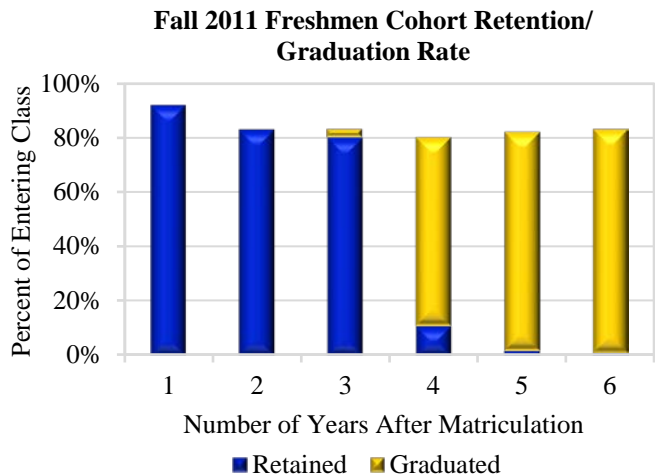

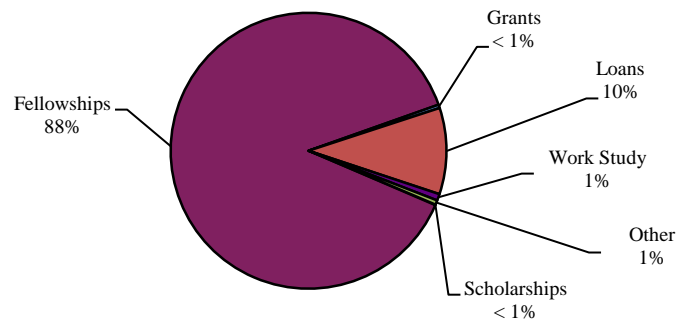

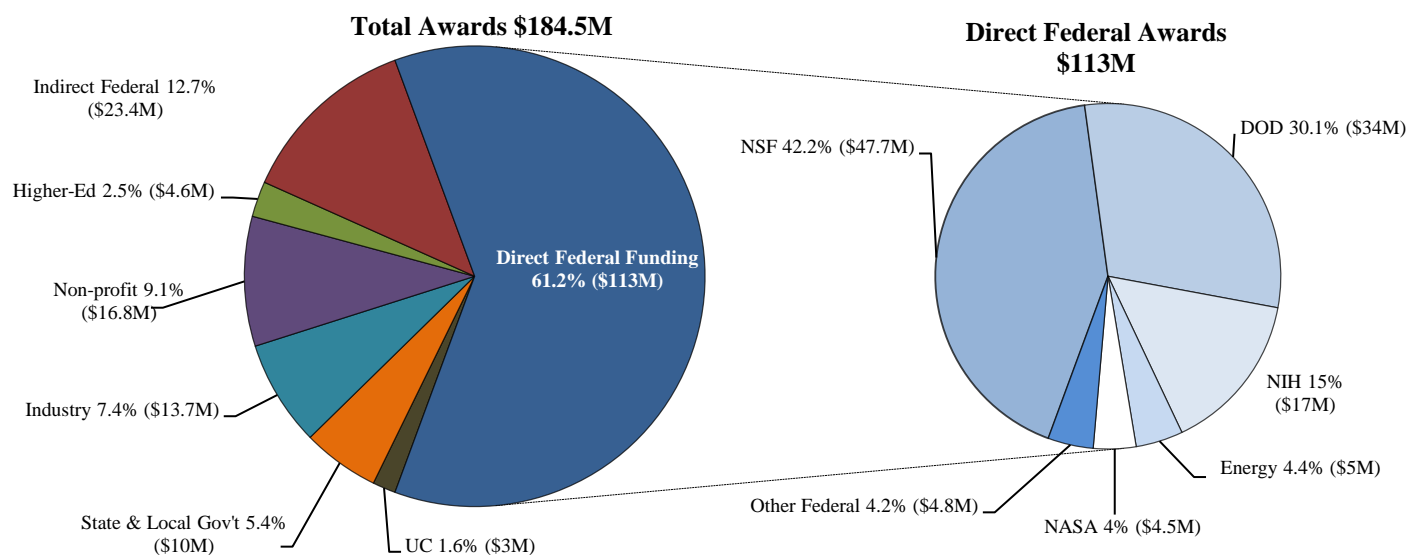
