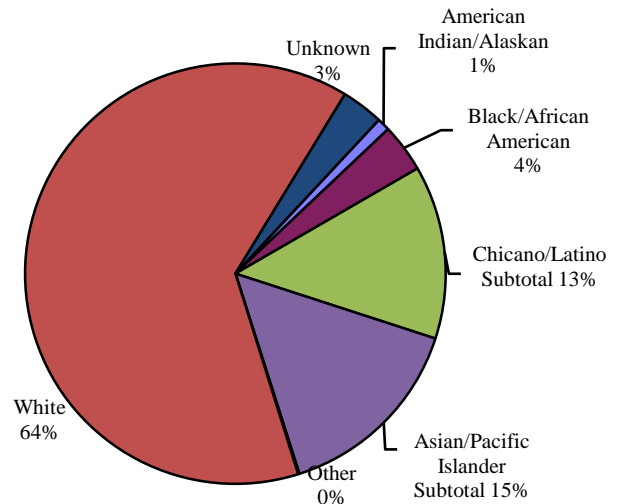

School of Origin

Of new undergraduates 67% entered as freshmen, while 33% transferred in at a higher class level. 77% of new freshmen students entered UCSB from public high schools; 11% graduated from private high schools or were home schooled.

The majority of transfer students came from community colleges (92%); nearly one fifth of transfer students came from Santa Barbara City College alone (17%). Other transfer students came from other University of California campuses (3%), the California State University system (1%), and other 4-year colleges (4%).

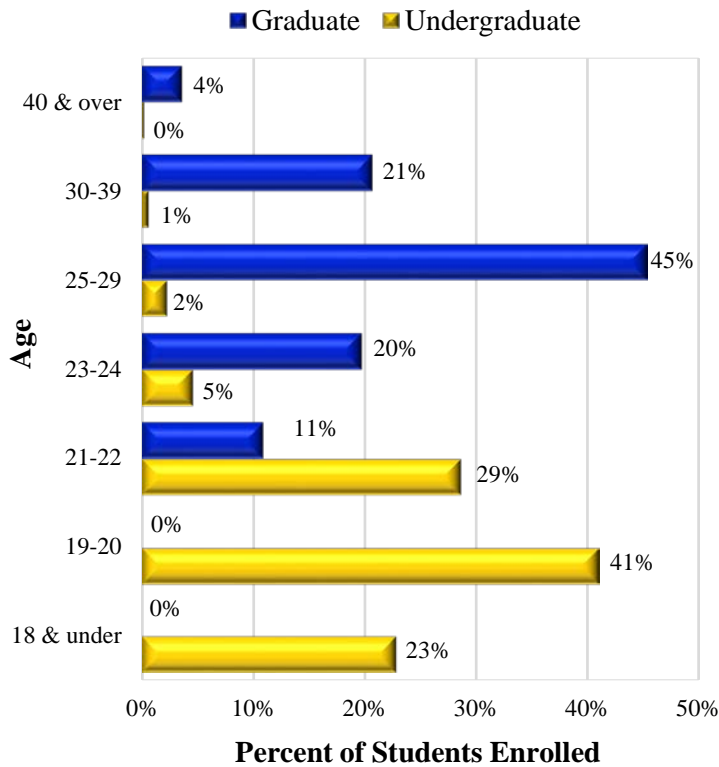

Age Distribution of Students by Class Level



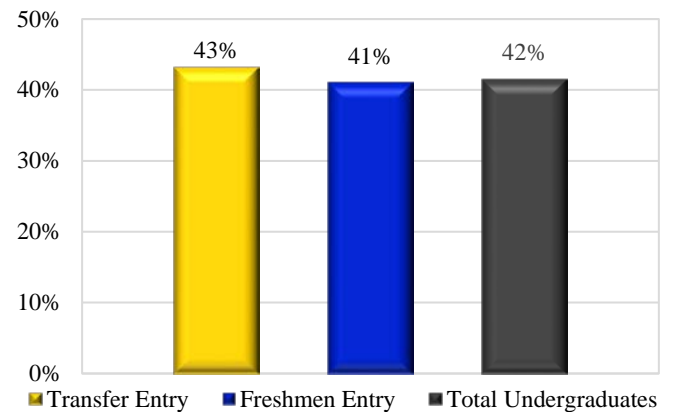

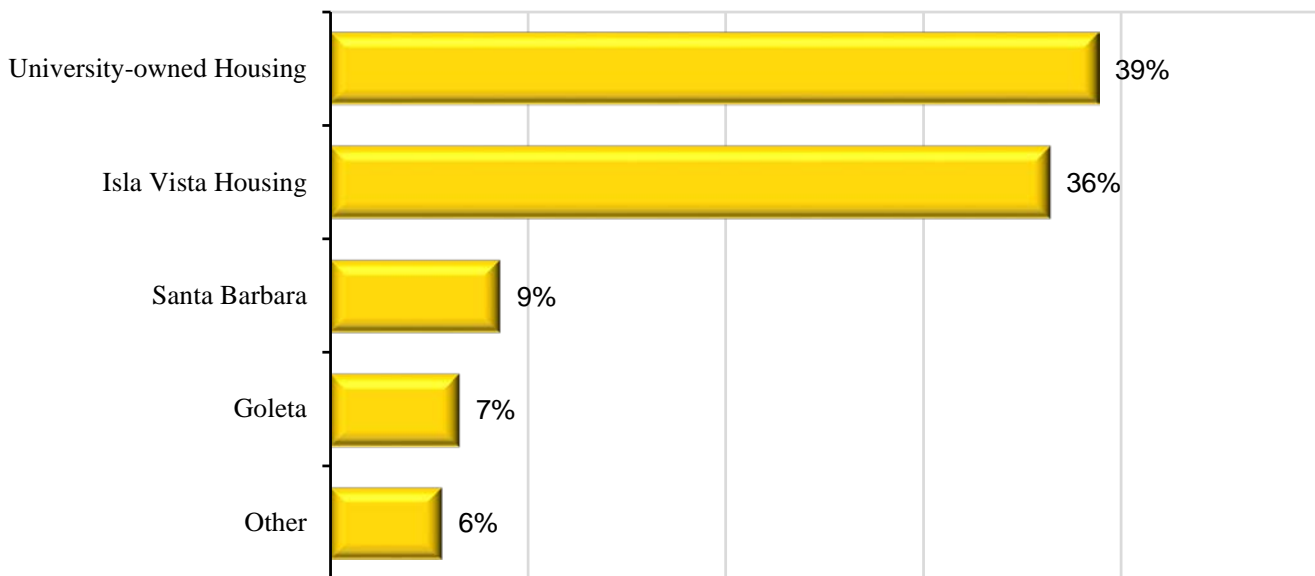

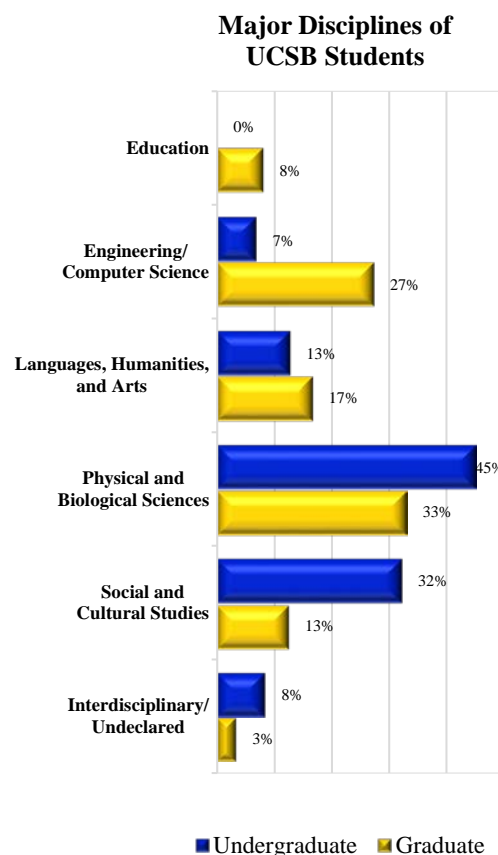


Percentage of UCSB Students

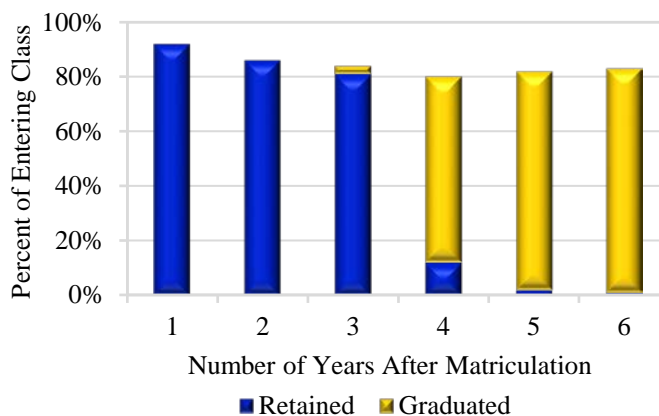

Fall 2012 Freshmen Cohort Retention/ Graduation Rate



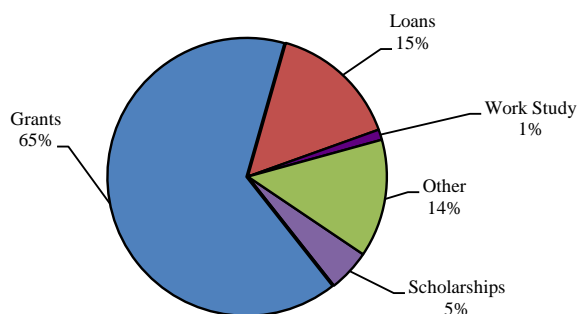

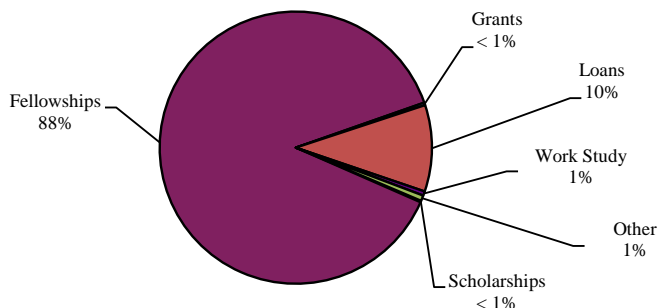
