

School of Origin

Of new undergraduates 70% entered as freshmen, while 30% transferred in at a higher class level. 74% of new freshmen students entered UCSB from public high schools; 11% graduated from private high schools or were home schooled.

The majority of transfer students came from community colleges (92%); nearly one fifth of transfer students came from Santa Barbara City College alone (17%). Other transfer students came from other University of California campuses (2%), the California State University system (1%), and other 4-year colleges (5%).



Age Distribution of Students by Class Level







Where UCSB Students Live*




Percentage of UCSB Students



Fall 2013 Freshmen Cohort Retention/ Graduation Rate






